Arrival to School

- Report immediately to your locker
- Must be in Period 1 by 7:40am.
- Use the time to get missed work, help from a teacher, print things in the Media Center
- Breakfast:
 - Cafeteria doors close at **7:33am**; students will not be allowed in after that time.
 - Must <u>have a pass</u> when leaving breakfast.
 - Students have until 7:43am to arrive in Period 1 (with a breakfast pass).




Tardy to School



- All students are expected to arrive to school on time each day
- Must be in Period 1 class by 7:40am
- Breakfast students: Must be in Period 1 class by 7:43am (with a breakfast pass)
- Students arriving after the designated times will be sent to the office for a Tardy to School pass
- Beginning February 27th, we will track <u>unexcused</u> tardies to school
- 3 tardies to school in a quarter = After school detention from 2:25pm-4:00pm
- Each consecutive tardy in the same quarter is another PM detention
- Restarts at beginning of 4th quarter

Hallway Expectations

- Agenda Books; Students must have signed pass in the hallway during class time
- Move quickly to class Lockers are only before and after school and before and after lunch
- Take the most direct route to class
- Stay to the right
- Follow BARK at all times
 - Clean up after yourself no trash in hallway
 - No music/speakers in hallway
 - \circ No food in the hallway



Classroom Expectations

- Follow BARK in the classroom.
- Be on time.
- Please bring all materials needed to class.
- Take all of your materials with you when you leave. Check your desk when you leave.
- Good behaviors: Above the line behaviors



Academic Expectations

- Complete and submit work on time.
- Do your own work. Do not share your work with other students unless it is part of a group activity.
- Assignments for classes should only be worked on in that content class.
- Check Canvas frequently.
- Do your best.



Late to Class (Don't do it!)

- Please be on time.
- If you are late, make sure you have a pass from your previous teacher or staff member.
- If you arrive without a pass, teachers will ask you to fill out the tardy log.
 - 1st Tardy: Warning
 - o 2nd Tardy: MIR
 - 3rd Tardy: Lunch Detention and Parent Contact
 - 4th Tardy: Office Referral



BYOD

- Devices are to be used for instructional purposes in the classroom
 - No devices/earbuds in classrooms unless teacher permission given
- One earbud in the cafeteria and the hallway
- No SPEAKERS at any time
- No pictures/videos allowed at school unless for instructional purposes and with the permission of your teacher
- No devices out in bathrooms/locker rooms

Lunch Expectations

- Be on time; have a signed pass from a staff member if arriving late
 - O 8th Grade: By 10:26am
 - o 7th Grade: By 11:19am
 - o 6th Grade: By 12:12pm
- Remain seated unless you have permission
- Use conversational voices
- Bathrooms during lunch sign out with staff member and take a pass



Lunch Expectations

- If you need help from a teacher during lunch:
 - Must have a pass from your teacher before you come to lunch
 - Must go immediately to lunch
- Keep area clean on the table and under the table
 - Will be required to clean up your area; stay back from recess/class to clean



Dismissal Expectations

- All walkers dismissed at 2:30pm AND remain in the building until buses dismissed
- All buses dismissed at 2:32pm; move quickly to the buses so you are not left behind
- Students picking up younger siblings at BBES:
 - You may not be in BBES
 - You may sit on the benches outside BBES or wait at PVMS
 - No play fighting or profanity
 - You may not be on their blacktop or fields until after the end of their school day



Dismissal Expectations

Bus riders should exit the building through the Bollman Bridge exits and head right to their assigned bus.

Walkers and car can be escorted by their 7th period teacher to Ms. Tompkins room (Chesapeake), Mr. Howe's room (Potomac), or Ms. Greene's room (From Ms. Greene's list).

Walkers and car riders will stay in their assigned room until they are dismissed at 2:30pm by the teacher in charge, then they will exit the building by the Vollmerhausen exits.
