- Who has been recognized?
 - At least 38 8th Graders!
 - \circ Stand up and be recognized!



Arrival to School

- Report immediately to your locker
- Must be in Period 1 by 7:40am
- Use the time to get missed work, help from a teacher, print things in the Media Center
- Breakfast:
 - Cafeteria doors close at 7:33am; will not be allowed in after that time
 - Must <u>have a pass</u> when leaving breakfast
 - Have until 7:43am to arrive in Period 1 (with a breakfast pass)



Tardy to School

- All students are expected to arrive to school on time each day
- Must be in Period 1 class by 7:40am
- Breakfast students: Must be in Period 1 class by 7:43am (with a breakfast pass)
- Students arriving after the designated times will be sent to the office for a Tardy to School pass
- Beginning February 27th, we will track **<u>unexcused</u>** tardies to school
- 3 tardies to school in a quarter = After school detention from 2:25pm-4:00pm
- Each consecutive tardy in the same quarter is another PM detention
- Restarts at beginning of 4th quarter



Hallway Expectations

- Agenda Books; Must have signed pass in the hallway during class time (You will be sent back if you do not have a pass)
- Move quickly to class
- Take the most direct route
- Stay to the right
- Follow BARK at all times
 - Clean up after yourself no trash in hallway
 - No music/speakers in hallway



Classroom Expectations

Food and Drink



- It is acceptable to carry a closed water container throughout the school day.
- ALL FOOD needs to be consumed in the cafeteria or kept stored in lockers.

Cell phones

- All devices must be placed in SILENT mode
- Be sure to follow the classroom teacher's expectations regarding cell phone usage at all times.
- Ear buds should not be visible once entering a classroom please put them away.

BARK!

Academic Expectations

- Students are constantly checking Canvas for announcements, assignment dates, and grades **YOU** are responsible for your grade!
- Studying and reviewing notes daily even when you do not have homework!
- Absent & Make-Up Work
 - Each day absent equals one day to make up work.
 - YOU are responsible for obtaining work from each class you were absent from and completing the assignments in the allotted time.

Late to Class

- You are responsible for making it to class ON TIME.
- When the LATE bell starts to ring and you are not physically in the classroom YOU ARE LATE!
- Levels of Consequences:
 - First lateness Verbal Warning
 - Second lateness MIR/Parent Contact
 - Third lateness Lunch Detention
 - Fourth lateness Referral



BYOD

- Devices are to be used for instructional purposes in the classroom
 - No devices/earbuds in classrooms unless teacher permission given
- One earbud in the cafeteria and the hallway
- No SPEAKERS at any time
- No pictures/videos allowed at school unless for instructional purposes and with the permission of your teacher
- No devices out in bathrooms/locker rooms



Lunch Expectations

- Be on time; have a signed pass from a staff member if arriving late
 - 8th Grade: By 10:26am
 - 7th Grade: By 11:19am
 - 6th Grade: By 12:12pm
- Remain seated unless you have permission
- Use conversational voices
- Bathrooms during lunch sign out with staff member and take a pass
- No food or drink allowed outside during recess



Lunch Expectations

- If you need help from a teacher during lunch:
 - Must have a pass from your teacher before you come to lunch
 - Will not be allowed to leave without a pass (even for SOS)
 - Must go immediately to lunch
- Keep area clean on the table and under the table
 - Will be required to clean up your area; stay back from recess/class to clean



Dismissal Expectations

- All walkers dismissed at 2:30pm **AND** remain in the building until buses dismissed
- All buses dismissed at 2:32pm; move quickly to the buses so you are not left behind
- Students picking up younger siblings at BBES:
 - You may not be in BBES
 - \circ ~ You may sit on the benches outside BBES or wait at PVMS ~
 - No play fighting or profanity
 - You may not be on their blacktop or fields until after the end of their school day
